

## Historic Churches of Old Bisbee

Experience the Presbyterian Church built in 1903 with its stained glass and Bavarian-made, hand-painted pipe organ. See Bisbee's oldest church, the First Methodist, built in 1900 by Cornish miners working nights after their shift in the mines. St. John's Episcopal was built in 1904 with a Tiffany stained glass window. Then visit the arched magnificence St. Patrick's Roman Catholic Church completed in 1917 in Gothic Revival style with Victorian stained glass windows down by renowned artist Emil Frye.
