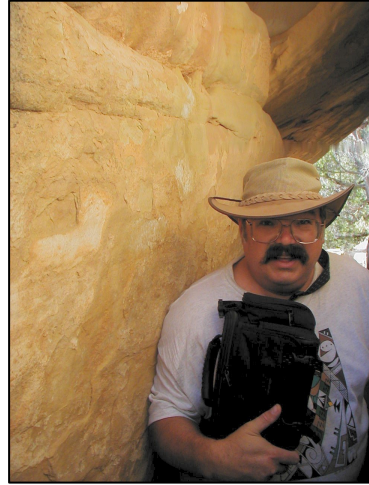


Doug Hocking

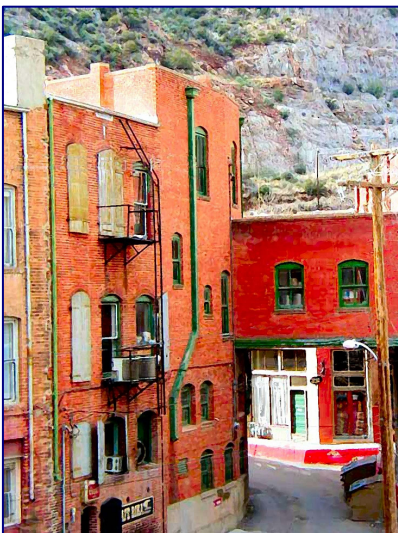
Digital Photography and Art
