Arizona Artist

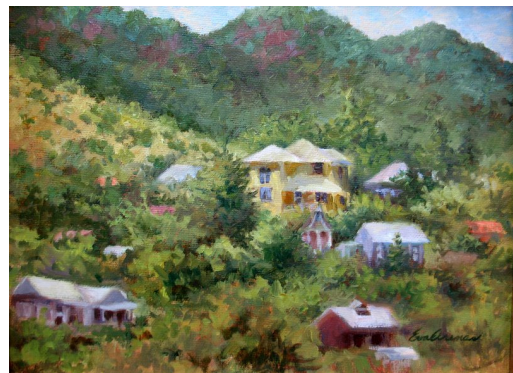
