Nancy Cutts is a self employed artist with a PhD in Family and Child Therapy. She completed an apprenticeship in Art Therapy at Harbor/ UCLA Medical Center, has a Master of Science degree in Recreational Therapy and a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree in Painting from Ohio University.

Dr. Cutts has published a book, **The Jewel Tree**, a story/ workbook for children with learning disabilities. The text and illustrations are created by the author. Nancy's Fine Art slides are now in the permanent collection of the National Women's Art Museum Archives in Washington DC., and can be viewed on the internet. Dr. Cutts' skills are diverse and she has integrated her expertise through painting, drama, poetry, and puppetry. Her work is a unique combination of fine art and therapeutic content.

Dr. Cutts has had three solo exhibitions: An exhibit at The Fairmount Creative and Performing Arts Center Gallery in Cleveland, Ohio; a performance art piece (Through the Crystal Ball) at The Institute of Dance and Contemporary Art in Santa Monica, California; and an additional exhibit of paintings (The Sequencha Series) at that gallery. Nancy has also exhibited in group shows in Ohio, Kansas, Mexico City, and California.

A highlight of Nancy's career was hosting expressive arts workshops in her own art studio/ gallery in Los Angeles for three years.

Dr. Cutts, born on April 16, 1950, now resides in Bisbee, Arizona. Media ranges from drawing, painting, environmental sculpture to performance art.
